- **1.** Period for keeping receipts for the club's accounts was discussed. It was felt as with normal practice they should be kept for a period of seven years. It was agreed to keep those over the value of £200 but scan the remaining receipts to reduce the volume of paperwork.
- **2.** Fort Stamford already has a booking for the evening of the Muddy Duck. Jill has booked The Kings Arms for 40-50 people, they will provide a chilli/curry/vegetarian dish for £200-250.
- **3.** Steve Rose gave a brief report on Muddy Duck arrangements. He has informed South West Water and the police of the event, assuring the police there would be adequate marshals for the areas of road. Plymouth City Council also have been contacted whom he has supplied with a more detailed risk assessment. The race licence may require a £500 refundable deposit. Steve Rose and Steve Leonard will re-run the route before the next Muddy Duck meeting. Vests will cost £5. Steve Leonard asked if we would consider adding an extra colour to the vest to improve the logo of the Bike Cellar. This would increase price to £6.20. It was decided not to add additional colour.

- **5.** Following some club members inquiries, entry to the club ballot regarding the EA membership by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016 was confirmed.
